*Girls Jumper, Skorts, Skirts, and Shorts must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.

**Shorts may be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, and May.

Tuition & Lunch Policies

Tuition:

Yearly tuition is divided into 10 equal monthly payments (August-May). Monthly tuition is due on the first of each month and is considered past due after the 15th. **You are asked to please notify the school principal, in advance, if you are unable to pay your monthly tuition by the 15th of the month.**

Lunches:

Lunch price: \$2.50 a day
 \$12.50 weekly

Mrs. Connie is an awesome cook! Her cafeteria meals are prepared fresh daily! You are asked to purchase your child's lunch ticket monthly or at the beginning of each week. A student will not be allowed to exceed 10 cafeteria charges. Once the student is nearing the 10 days, the school secretary will contact the parents.

Students have the option to bring a lunchbox from home but we ask that the lunchbox contain **NO CANDY NOR SODAS** (in correspondence to Texas health guidelines). We also ask that St. Joseph students respect the Catholic Religion by not including meat products in their lunchboxes on *Meatless Fridays* during the Lenten Season (Lent is during the second semester, the school menu will notify parents of Meatless Fridays).
